The City of Pinole agrees with Finding #12.


Recommendations

We hope that the Grand Jury will find these responses helpful.

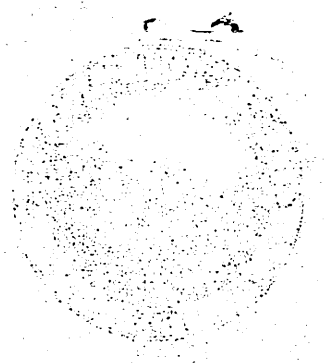
